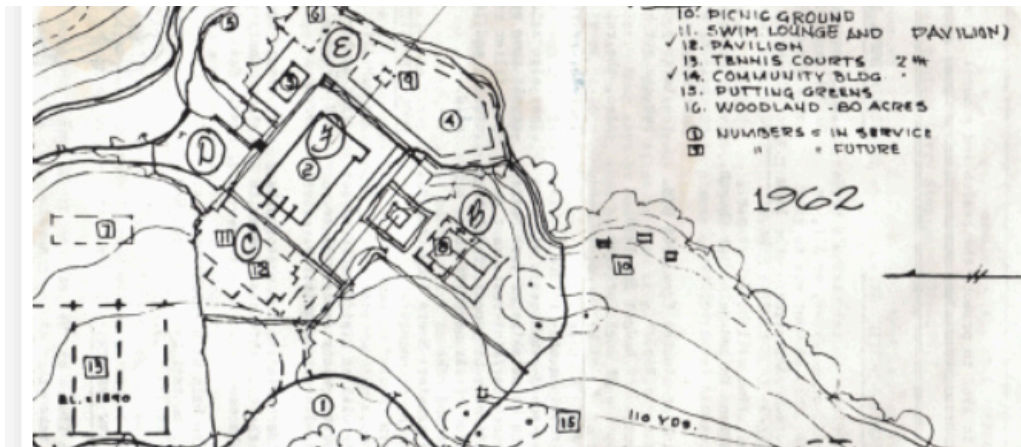

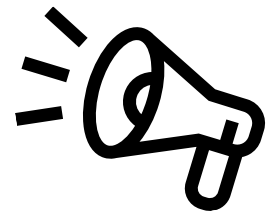

NEW POLICY



To improve safety in and around the pool the pool board has made the following changes to the unattended minors policy at the pool.

Children under the age of 10 must have a supervising adult present at all times.

Children between the ages of 11-15 can be at the pool without an adult if these requirements are met:

1. The child must pass the Scouts of America swim test as judged by head guards and managers.
2. A parental consent waiver must be signed annually and kept in the front office.

SWIM TESTS will be provided on the first Sunday of every month from 12-1 pm. The test will be offered the following Sunday in the event of rain.

Q: If my child's babysitter is under 15 do, they also need to take the swim test?

A: Yes, all children ages 11-15 must pass the swim test to be at the pool without an adult.

Q: My child is on the swim team and can swim well. Do they need to take the test?

A: Yes, all children ages 11-15 must pass the swim test to be at the pool without an adult.

Q: How will you know who takes and passes the swim test?

A: There will be an annotation in the membership logs for children who have met the requirements above and are allowed to be at the pool without an adult.

Q: What if my child misses the swim test day?

A: We will offer the swim test the first Sunday of every month from 12-1 pm.

Safety Reminders

- There are NO lifeguards on duty at the baby pool! A parent or guardian must be present at the baby pool with their child.
- The baby pool is for children ages 6 years and under.
- Children wearing "floaties" must be within arm's reach of a guardian in the water.
- Floaties are not allowed in the deep end of the pool to include the diving board.
