### **Weather Policy**

Pool will be closed when rain interferes with the performance of the lifeguards. Pool will re-open when the manager on duty deems it safe. The pool will remain closed for 20 minutes from time of last thunder. If lightning is spotted, the pool will be closed and the deck will be cleared. The pool will remain closed for 30 minutes.

Thunderstorm Watch or Warning -Tornado Watch or Warning - POOL CLOSED. Management reserves the right to close the pool for as long as the weather is predicted to remain poor.

### **Guest Policy**

A member in good standing must accompany each guest and remain on the grounds with the guest. Out-of-town guests will be admitted free of charge when accompanied by a member. Babysitters (must be pre-approved by the Board) will be admitted free when accompanied with your child. Grandchildren who live in Huntsville and are under the age of 18 will be allowed to use the Club facilities and participate in swim team without paying guest fees. All other guests will be charged \$3.

## **Safety Policies**

- 1. Red Cross or Coast Guard-approved flotation devices are strongly suggested for children who do not know how to swim.
- 2. Children under 38" tall must have a parent or sitter in the water at all times. Flotation devices WILL NOT be accepted as a substitute for a parent or sitter.
- 3. The Pool Manager, Lifeguards, and Board Members have the authority to enforce safety and health regulations and to maintain good order. This shall include authority to evict offenders from the Club property.
- 4. It should be noted that Pool Staff are not to be considered baby-sitters. Children between the ages of 8 and 12 must have a 2012 Permission Form on file in the pool office before any child can be left at the pool without adult supervision. It should also be noted that the child must be able to swim the width of the pool before the Permission Form can be approved by the Manager. These rules are in place to ensure everyone's safety.
